Global sales of cranes for construction applications, devastated by the global recession that began in 2008, bottomed out in late in 2010 and continue to recover. However, the effects of the downturn and pace of recovery on crane demand have varied considerably around the globe.

These differences are attributable to different economic circumstances in the major regions of the world, but also to differences in demand for the major types – crawler, tower, and mobile – of cranes used in construction. In fact, it is somewhat misleading to consider the market a global one.
